Minimally invasive surgery, popularly known as "keyhole surgery", is a new standard for surgical disciplines. Using a fine viewing instrument inserted into the patient to manoeuvre and treat or remove a diseased organ, surgeons no longer need to open up a big incision on the patient.

Dr Philip Chiu (1987) is the Associate Professor and Honorary Consultant of the Department of Surgery at the Prince of Wales Hospital. He developed his clinical skills from many local and overseas experts from Japan and the USA. In 2000, Dr Chiu was granted the outstanding staff and teams award, marking his excellent work in clinical service. Our LSCOBA Jan 2008 Newsletter reported that Dr Chiu's Gastrointestinal Research Group won the 2007 State Scientific and Technological Progress Award (SSTPA) for its achievement and innovation in the treatment of peptic ulcer bleeding. The SSTPA is a highly prestigious award in the science and technology field on the Mainland.
