Candidates up to the number of vacancies who shall receive most votes shall be declared elected and in the case of two or more candidates receiving an equal number of votes, a second and subsequent ballots shall be held until a candidate receives most votes."

Any member who wishes to stand for election at the Annual General Meeting should complete the nomination form attached to this notice and return it to the Returning Officer on or before 17 July, 1991 Members are also reminded to bring their membership cards to the Annual General Meeting to facilitate the conduct of business.
